

School Parent Involvement Policy Title I, Section 1118(b)

- Must be developed with, distributed to and agreed upon by parents of participating children.
 - What: Describe the means for carrying out the requirements of section 1118 © through (f). Update periodically to meet the changing needs of parents and the school.
- A. Each school shall:
1. convene an annual meeting
 2. offer a flexible number of meetings
 3. involve parents in the planning, review, and improvement of programs under Title I
 4. provide parents of participating children
 - timely information about Title I programs
 - school performance profiles and individual assessment results
 - a description and explanation of the curriculum, opportunities for regular meetings
 - timely response to parents' suggestions; and
 5. if the school wide program plan is not satisfactory, submit parent comments to the LEA
- B. Develop jointly with parents a school-parent compact that outlines how parents, the entire school staff, and students will share the responsibility for improved student achievement and the means by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership to help children achieve and the means by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership to help children achieve the State's high standards;
- C. Build capacity for involving parents; and
- D. To the extent practicable provide full opportunities for the participation of parents with limited English proficiency or with disabilities.
